Conditions of Entry

- All fees must be paid by 20th September Nomination fees are non refundable (except in the event of
 postponement or cancellation) and MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM, CODE OF CONDUCT AND PSSA
 PARENTAL CONSENT AND MEDICAL INFORMATION SHEET. If these are not signed your entry cannot be
 accepted
- 2. 1 master/team entry form only per school will be accepted –entries must be collated by the school and sent together.
- 3. Entry form to be signed by parent and School Principal you are representing your school.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the parent to exercise a duty of care, ensuring their child is mounted on a suitable horse, rider and horse equipment are to Pony Club standards and the rider is competent to compete safely.
- 5. Maximum 200 riders on the day. Entries will be processed and accepted on a first in basis; once 200 entrants are received books will be closed.
- 6. Telephone or fax entries will not be accepted all entries must be complete and posted with money.
- 7. No late entries will be accepted.
- 8. Age will be "age competitor turns this year" as at 31 December 2012
- 9. Minimum age 8 Years as at 31 December 2012.
- 10. Schools may enter any number of students
- 11. One horse one rider on the day
- 12. Groups will be split into each age group, however the committee has the right to amend or combine age groups where it feels appropriate, in regard to small numbered groups.
- 13. The competition will be run under Pony Club Association Guidelines; however the committee has the right to amend at their discretion.
- 14. All riders must wear an AS/NZ3838 approved helmet at all times whilst mounted. Any competitor not complying with this ruling will be asked to leave the ring and will not be permitted to compete.
- 15. The uniform on the day will be jodhpurs or cream stockman cut trousers, approved Pony Club boots, safety helmet (AS/NZ3838), school jumper, shirt and tie. No jackets or blazers, sporting shirts may be worn if desired for the sporting events only.
- 16. A gear check is required prior to competitors warming up or entering the ring. If gear is changed during the day, a gear check must be redone by your team manager prior to entering the next event. Old gear check stickers must be removed prior to the days gear check. Spot gear checks will be done during the day.
- 17. Parents are not to follow riders around the sporting events. We ask that parents remain outside the ring or bunting. All riders must be competent and should not require assistance
- 18. NO DOGS OR STALLIONS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS
- 19. No LEDS
- 20. Each competing school MUST provide the name of at least two (2) Workers other than the team manager to assist on the day. These workers are required to report to the office at the start of the day. And may be asked to help with stewarding an age group or running a sporting event.
- 21. Schools will be notified of their acceptance of entries via email
- 22. Disputes must be lodged in writing, by the Team Manager, to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the completion of the event. A fee of \$50.00 must be lodged simultaneously and will be forfeited if the protest is dismissed.
- 23. For the purpose of School championship points only, the team will comprise the top four (4) riders on the day from your school.
- 24. This event is run under the NSW Public School Sporting Assoc (PSSA), private institutions are not covered and we therefore require a copy of your schools **Certificate of Currency** for the Student Accident Policy/Public Liability before your student(s) can compete.

TEAM MANAGERS RESPONSIBILITIES

Please read this information and pass it on to your competitors.

- Team managers must have suitable horse experience.
- Scratchings Please notify the office of scratchings as soon as possible.
- ♦ Team Managers are required to carry out a gear check on all your competitors/horses according to Pony Club standards. Gear must be checked before warming up or prior to 9am start **and** in the event of a rider replacing or changing gear. Spot gear checks will be done during the day.
- ♦ All old gear check stickers must be removed from helmets at gear check. Each child must have a sticker on their helmet to say they have had a gear check.
- Workers A minimum of two workers are required to assist the host school on the day. It is your responsibility to ensure that workers are available on time and move to the area designated. Workers will be asked to time and record a sporting event, and help setup and pack up a sporting event. A listing will be provided prior to the competition. It is not always necessary that the worker remains at the specific activity for the full duration. The job can be shared amongst other parents from your school. However, if a worker is timing an event for example the 13 year Keyhole they must remain until that specific age group has been completed before a replacement steps in. Your assistance in ensuring that a worker be available where designated is greatly appreciated to ensure that the day runs smoothly.
- Parents are not to follow riders around the sporting events. We ask that parents remain outside the ring
 or bunting. All riders must be competent, should not require assistance and must be mounted on
 a suitable horse.
- Programme please ensure competitors know where they are competing.
- ♦ Disputes should an incident arise disputes must be lodged in writing with a \$50 fee by the Team Manager within 15 minutes of the completion of the event. Communication will only be dealt with between the Team Managers and Officials.
- Presentation A trophy will be awarded to the Champion Primary and Secondary School Teams.
 Trophies will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion in each age group. We would like to encourage riders to stay for the presentation.
- ◆ Team manager has a DUTY OF CARE to students, and are responsible for student supervision and behaviour.
