

Students need to understand that learning an instrument is a commitment and they will need to practise daily. Keyboard and guitar tuition costs \$10/ week for small group lessons. All lessons need to be paid for in advance, as the tutors are committing their time to our school. Fees for lessons when students are absent cannot be refunded.

Kids Connection Program

Beginning in Week 2 of Term 1 2013, we will be running a program for the Year 5 and Year 6 students focusing on improving the welfare of children by developing healthy relationships. The overall aim of the program is for children to build resilience in their relationships to increase the child's:-

- Recognition and understanding of healthy and unhealthy relationships.
- Skills and strategies in problem solving and communication.
- Confidence in being assertive when relationships are unsafe or unhealthy.

The program itself is developed and presented by Interrelate Family Centre as a free service to school children in these classes only. It consists of three hour and a half sessions to be held during school hours on three consecutive Wednesdays 6/2, 13/2 and 20/2.
