PSSA Zone Athletics

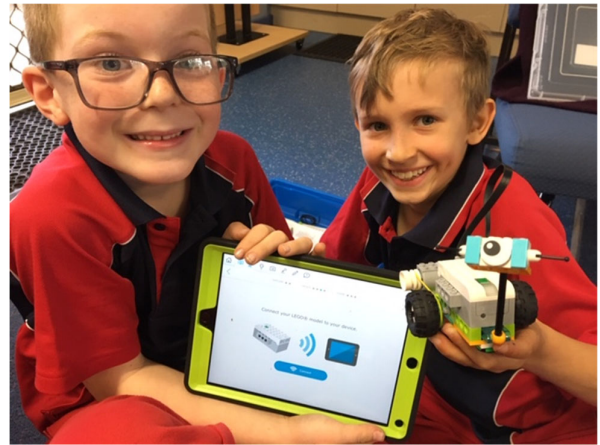
