School Contribution Fee

All families in NSW public schools are asked to make a contribution to the ongoing costs associated with providing a quality education. Unlike some schools, Iona Public School does not have text book fees and provides writing booklets, exercise books, worksheets and access to subscribed Internet-based literacy programs such as Spelling City and Ziptales. Accordingly, we ask you to make a small contribution of \$20 to cover the cost of folders, photocopy paper, exercise books, headphones and computer consumables. Our Creative and Practical Arts contribution is \$10 per term. This year we have subscribed to Sound Waves, Mathletics and Reading Eggs. These will be used weekly in class and can be accessed from home. The cost of covering the licence fees for these is \$60. The voluntary contribution fee is \$48. This means the total fee contribution is set at \$168. School Attendance

Research has shown very clearly that poor attendance puts students at greater risk. Poor attendance begins at a low level, such as staying at home to help with younger siblings, going to the movies, or shopping with friends and if this is allowed to continue can be a habit that is hard to break at the beginning of a new school term and during the school year.

If your child is absent from school, parents are legally required to notify the school, explaining the absence, within 7 days. This can be done in a number of ways:

- Phone or email If you know your child is going to be away from school please contact the school via phone (02) 49301415 or email (iona p.school@det.nsw.edu.au) to explain the absence.
- Letter On the day your child returns to school after an absence send a note explaining the absence. This note is to be handed in at the Office or to Class Teacher.
- Skoolbag Please complete the Skoolbag absentee form on the day of absence.

If your child arrives after 9.00am <u>ALL PARENTS</u> must report to the office and explain their late arrival. Students will be given a late pass to be handed to their classroom teacher.
