School Contribution Fee

All families in NSW public schools are asked to make a contribution to the ongoing costs associated with providing a quality education. Unlike some schools, Iona Public School does not have text book fees and provides writing booklets, exercise books, worksheets and access to subscribed Internet-based literacy programs such as Spelling City and Ziptales. Accordingly, we ask you to make a small contribution of \$20 to cover the cost of folders, photocopy paper, exercise books, headphones and computer consumables. Our Creative and Practical Arts contribution is \$40 (\$10 per term) This year we have subscribed to Sound Waves, Mathletics, iMaths and Reading Eggs. These will be used weekly in class and can be accessed from home. The cost of covering the licence fees for these is \$80. The voluntary contribution fee is \$49. This means the total fee contribution is set at \$189. 




3-6 News
